 - c) Family and friends (I've got two brothers and one sister)

Present Continuous:

Use the Present Continuous:

To express the idea that something is happening now, at this very moment.
It can also be used to show that something is not happening now.

FORM:

am/is/are +

present participle (verb+ing)

I am working.

She is working.

We are working.

They are working.

You are working.

Positive:

You are watching TV.

Question:

Are you watching TV? Yes, I am (+), No, I'm not (-)

Is she watching TV? Yes, She is (+), No, She isn't (-)

Negative:

You are not watching TV. You aren't working

She is not watching TV. She isn't watching TV

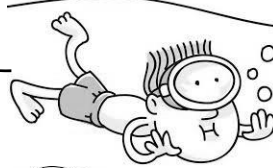
